We have learnt that the Havant Borough Local Plan has put Park Wood as a DESIGNATED GREEN SPACE. This is to comply with Government requirements SO CANNOT BE DEVELOPED. We would like to feel that Park Wood is there because of the hard work of the F of PW and of the vision John Carter, to whom we owe a great deal.
