As many of you will know we have embarked on a holly clearing process in line with guidelines from the Woodland Trust. With the help of the volunteers from the SSEB this process is well under way. Our aim is to reduce the holly by two thirds, over a three year period, this in turn will give more light to the woodland floor and promote more of the natural flora to flourish. This was evident last spring and early summer with a beautiful display of celandine and bluebells.
